Texas License to Carry Class Agreement

The Texas LTC Coach

<u>I understand</u> the following:

- 1. The Texas LTC class is <u>not</u> designed for new or inexperienced shooters. If a student does not pass the shooting proficiency test the first time, he or she may shoot it again if time and the situation allows. If the student does not pass during the class, the instructor will schedule another chance for an extra fee (\$30-40) <u>or</u> the student can choose to shoot the proficiency test with a different instructor.
- The class covers the 4 required subjects and optional subjects to meet the state of Texas' requirements for the license to carry course. It is not designed or intended for specific personal defense training.
- 3. Refunds for the class will not be given if a student does not pass the written or shooting proficiency test. The instructor will work with a student to pass <u>if possible</u>.
- 4. If a student has to discontinue the class for any reason, the course fee will not be refunded but he or she can reschedule to attend an upcoming class.
- 5. A student may be removed from the class or shooting proficiency test if the student is unsafe, disruptive or uncooperative. If a student is removed from the class, it has to be reported to the Texas Department of Public Safety.
- 6. The instructor is not qualified to give specific legal advice. Seek qualified legal advice.
- 7. No handguns or ammunition are allowed in the classroom without instructor approval. Handguns are to be unloaded and safely stored in a case, box or range bag.
- 8. Students must follow <u>all</u> the instructor's directions and help maintain safety at all times.
- 9. Texas LTC classes are at least 4 hours in the classroom <u>plus</u> the time required for the written and shooting tests as required by law. Students must attend all class hours and pass the written and shooting tests to receive the LTC-100 Certificate of Training.
- 10. If bad weather occurs, the shooting proficiency test will be rescheduled ASAP.
- 11. A replacement LTC-100 Certificate of Training is \$10 (if lost).

Handgun Use and Range Safety Agreement

<u>I understand</u> that handling and shooting a handgun is usually a very safe activity if safety rules are strictly and consistently followed. <u>I understand</u> that activities involving handguns can cause serious injury or death if safety rules are not strictly followed.

- I will not handle my handgun or ammunition in the classroom or parking lot.
- I will not handle my handgun or ammunition at the range until directed to do so by the instructor.
- I will keep my handgun unloaded until I am directed to load it by the instructor.
- I will treat my handgun as if it is loaded at all times.
- I will keep my finger off of the trigger until I have been instructed to shoot.
- I will keep my handgun pointed at the target area at all times. I will not point my handgun in an unsafe direction or at any person at any time. I will not point my handgun at any part of my body or put any part of my body in front of the muzzle.
- I will stay behind the firing line at all times until the range is made and declared "safe" by the instructor.
- I will follow all the directions of the handgun instructor. I will wait or ask for instructions if I am unsure.
- I will wear ear and eye protection.
- I will watch out for my own safety and the safety of other students and immediately alert the instructor if a safety hazard is present.
- I am not under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- My handgun and ammunition, to the best of my knowledge, are safe to use.

I have read these safety rules and procedures and agree to follow all of them.
